- Stay and play- Wednesday 10th June 9-9:45

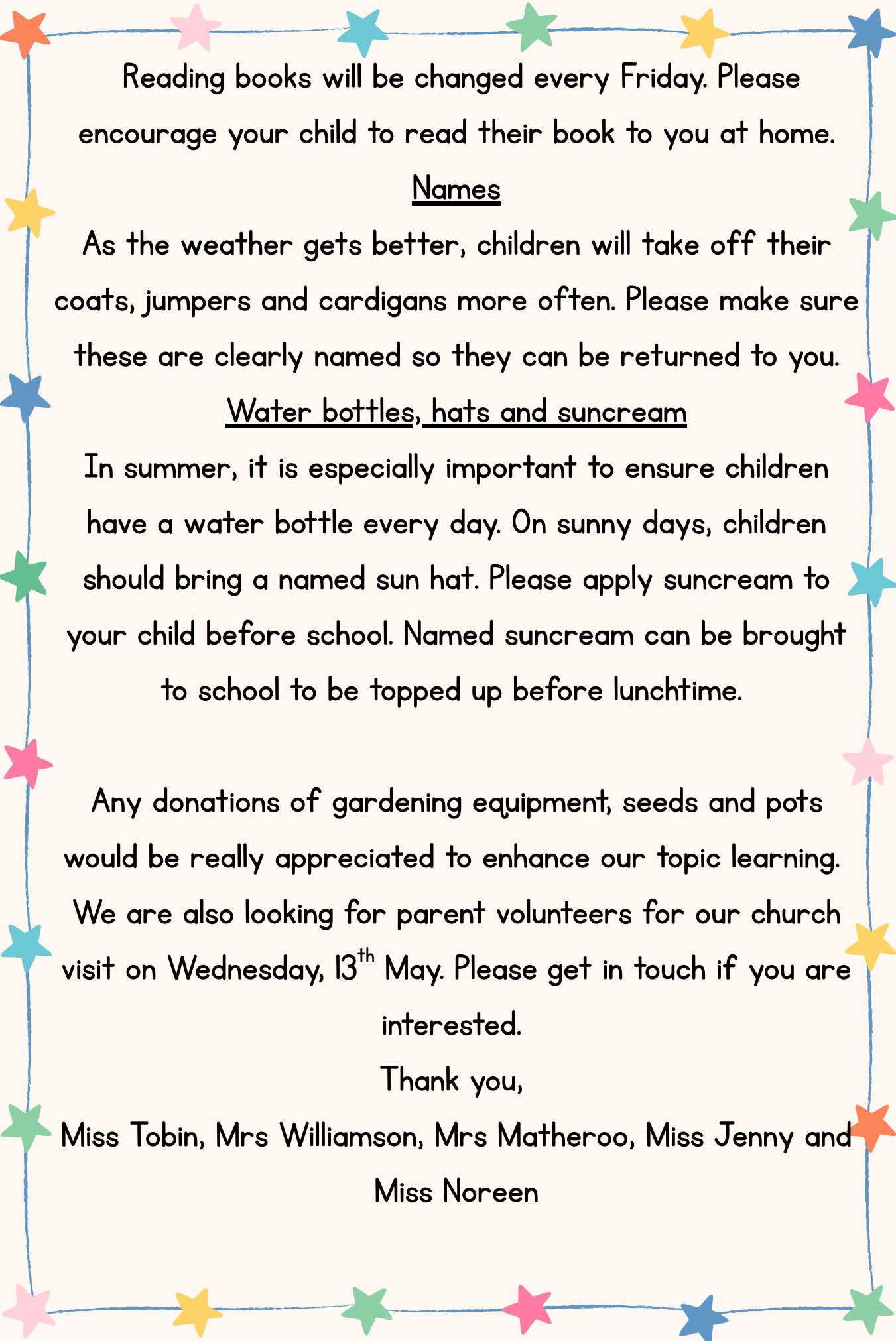
I wonder who lives here?
