We had a fantastic day at Nell Bank last week learning more about plants and habitats for our science work. Have a look at the photos on the class pages of the website to find out more about what we did. We are investigating plants over the next couple of weeks to find out more about the parts of a plant and how seeds grow. Everyone has enjoyed planting seeds too.



This term we will be learning all about 'Ancient Egypt'. We will be learning more about the pyramids, the river Nile, what daily life was like and mummification. Keep practising Times Table multiplication and division facts too. Some children know almost every fact now which is brilliant. Times Table Rockstars and Hit the button are excellent for learning maths facts at home. We are still doing a lot of work in school learning to join up handwriting correctly and learning high frequency spellings. Thank you for practising these at home too.
