

Outdoor Spelling

Here are some ideas that you could use to practise your spellings outside.

- **Rainbow words**—Write your words in coloured chalk.
- **Water and sand words**—With your finger, trace your word in the water or in some sand.
- **Spelling flower**—Find a flower or tree and have a go at drawing it. Write the letters from your word onto the petals or leaves.
- **Air Write**— Write the word in the air using your finger. Ask someone to read your word as you write.
