Can you measure the height of different people in your house? Who is the tallest? Who is the shortest?



Spotting numbers – Can you go on a number walk and see how many numbers you can see? Look at house doors, buses and signs for lots of numbers!



Use different items around the house like spaghetti to make different shapes.



Go a nature hunt and collect objects. How could you sort these into different groups?



Make some paper aeroplanes and see which can travel the furthest.



Invent your own maths game and play it with your family.
