

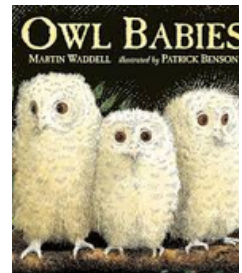
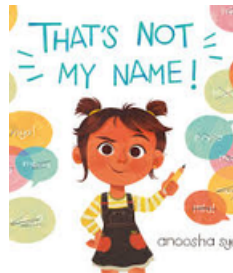
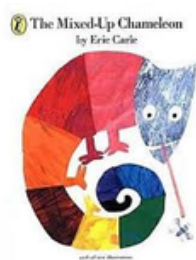
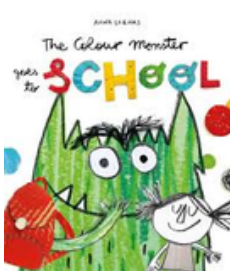
RECEPTION NEWSLETTER

Your child will be participating in the reception baseline assessment (RBA) within the first 6 weeks of starting reception. The purpose of the assessment is to provide the starting point for a progress measure that will help parents understand how well schools support their pupils to progress between reception and year 6.

Outdoor learning

In reception we will be outside everyday no matter the weather. Please send your child to school with a waterproof coat for wet and rainy days. We have a brand new wellie rack in our outdoor area. If your child has a pair of wellies these can be kept at school so they are always ready to be outside. Please make sure these are named.
