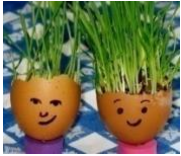

Year 1	Which books and stories are special? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> <u>Talk Time at home</u> What is your favourite book? What is it about? Why do you like it? How do you show that you care for it? 	How do we celebrate special events? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> *Bring in photos of ways in which you have experienced celebration (weddings, baptisms, special achievements). *Plant seeds and grow plants in your house or in the garden. Bring them into school when you have harvested them. *Create art using natural materials. Why do Christians Celebrate Christmas? Theme - Giving and Receiving <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Ask your child children to think quietly about what they give and receive (at Christmas, Eid or a just to be kind). Remind them that giving and receiving can include acts of kindness too. Children to think of one gift of kindness they can give to a member in their family	What does it mean to belong to a church or a mosque? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Play 'spot the symbols' when you are in the car or on the bus.  Den building: create a special place inside or in your garden or in the woods with a grown up. Bring a photograph into school and say how it felt making this and being inside it.  	What Makes Easter Important for Christians? Theme - symbols <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Grow bulbs, cress or similar at home.  	How and why do we care for others <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Who do you care about? Bring in a photograph of someone you care about. Read 'The Rainbow Fish', 'Can't You Sleep Little Bear' or similar story – discuss how and why they care. 	Who brought messages about God and what did they say <u>Home Learning Idea</u> During this unit the children will explore bible stories, including Noah. These are some craft ideas you could do at home... *Make a Noah's Ark mobile or collage.  *Build a boat using construction materials or items around your home.
