Year 2	How is new life welcomed? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Find out about your own name, meanings and reasons for the choice. Does your name have a meaning? Are you named after someone else? Is there a story to go with your name? Share what you have found out in class. Design something for a new baby and record this design on a piece of paper. 	How can we make good choices? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> What rules should we follow to keep the outdoors looking beautiful? Create a poster to show these rules. Why do Christians Celebrate Christmas? Theme - Light <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Write... 'One way I could bring light to the world' (e.g. doing a kind action, saying a kind thought) 	How and why do people pray? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Outdoor spaces can be effective in encouraging stillness and meditation. Create a 'sacred space' in the garden. Take a picture of this special place and bring it into school to share with your class. 	What Makes Easter Important for Christians? Theme-Church celebrations <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Think about a time when you have celebrated with a special meal (birthdays, weddings, Christmas, welcome home). What did you enjoy and what did you do? What was shared? What foods were consumed? What was being remembered in the celebration? 	How can we look after the planet? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Go to a park, wood or open area with your grown up. Awe and wonder walk – use all the senses to enjoy the outdoor space. Lie on the ground and look up. Touch, listen and smell. Where did it all come from? Remind the children not to look directly at the sun. 	What did Jesus teach and how did he live? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Read stories about being a good friend. e.g. Farmer Duck, Joy Martin Waddell, My Best Friend by Pat Hutchinson, Rainbow Fish or One Snowy Night
