Theme- The Gospel Accounts (Messages And Messengers) <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Create an imaginative piece of writing exploring the nativity from a particular person's standpoint. Theme- Who Was Jesus? <u>Home Learning Idea</u> Write a newspaper article for 'The Underground Freedom Fighter's Press' on 'Who is Jesus?' presenting him as a mysterious heavenly being perhaps leading a Jewish army.
