Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to tell you about an exciting new language app that our KS2 pupils can use as part of the new French resources we have invested in as a school.

We are now using **Language Angels** to support the teaching and learning of French, and they have just launched a **new, free app for Apple and Android devices** with access to a range of interactive games and karaoke. Language learning is best done little and often, so using this app at home will greatly boost their knowledge and skills in French; it will also be a lot of fun!

Login Details

You will be able to find the app by visiting the App Store from any Apple or Android device and searching for 'Language Angels'. Please look out for the angel character in the app icon so you know you are downloading the correct app.



Your child then can use the app by using the following simple log in details.

Username: la2023app

Password: la2023app

(NB: username and password are case sensitive.)

When your child logs on, they will have access to all the interactive games and karaoke videos. They need to choose **French** as their language; then choose between the **Games** or **Karaoke** icon.

Games Icon

When they click on the Games icon, they will be offered **Challenge Levels 1-4**. If they want to practise their French phonics, they need to go on **Level 1** and scroll down until they see the **La Phonétique unit**. **Year 3** should choose **Lesson 1**, **Year 4 Lesson 2** and **Year 5 & 6 Lesson 3**.

If your child wants to practise other topic-based units, **Year 3** should go to **Level 2** and choose the familiar units they have covered in class; **Year 4-6** should choose **Level 3** and find their familiar units. To build on their learning most effectively, children should only work within the levels and units they have covered in class.

Karaoke Icon

When children click on this icon, they will have access to all the songs from the scheme and should scroll down the topic headings to find the ones they have covered in class.

The app is completely safe for your child to use and there is no way for children to be able to contact or interact with anyone else on the app.

Access to Language Angel Games and Karaoke via the Website

If it is not possible for your child to access the Language Angels app, they can still access their year group games and songs via the Language Angels website:
