

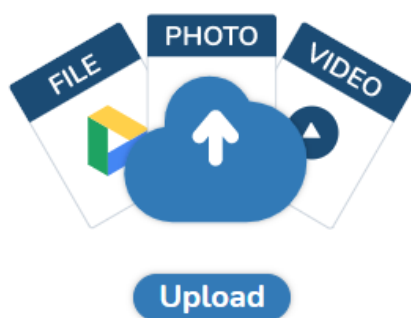
A guide to uploading work to SeeSaw

Here is a guide to help when uploading work to Seesaw, just remember that you will need to have downloaded the 'student app' from your app store if using this on a mobile device. From a laptop the steps are the same but you can access SeeSaw from their website: web.seesaw.me .Please follow these steps when uploading work to SeeSaw:

1. Press on the green '+' button at the top of the page



2. Select the 'upload' option if you are planning to share pictures or documents that are already saved on the device.



- You can use the app to take photographs of work. To do this, press the camera option (if uploading through a laptop this option might not be available):

- When you have taken a clear photograph, or uploaded a previously taken photograph or document you can then write a brief description of the work (e.g. here is the English work for 13/01/21) feel free to include a statement of anything that was found to be tricky. To do this then press on the speech marks:

- When uploading work from the same topic can you please then press on the add page option, this will allow you to add multiple pictures or documents to the post. This way all of one subject's learning will be in one post (e.g. all the maths work can be added to one post and then a separate post with English and another with guided reading and so on).
- Please can we avoid attaching work to direct messages to the class teacher's inbox on SeeSaw as this can be challenging to work through and mark, instead use these steps to upload all of the amazing learning you have been doing at home.
