The mark making link will give you some ideas on how to do this at home. If your child has started forming letters from their name you could use the writing repeat link to help them with this. It works on laptops and tablets, you can show them

		how to do this and they can copy using their finger before writing on paper.

For example S-socks O-orange, P-pan, C- cat, M- milk and so on. Get them to repeat this back to you. Concentrate on the set 1 sounds. Children can watch the video and repeat the sounds.
