Town – A place with many streets and building. It is larger than a village and smaller city.

Village – A village is a community made up of a small number of houses and it usually surrounded by countryside.

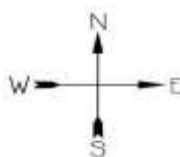
