Facts to learn

Children will learn:

- To describe how they feel, for example happy, sad, excited, scared
- That families can live in different houses. Some might have a brother or a sister, cousins, grandparents.
- That we are different to our friends for example we may have different colour hair, different bag but we also have lots of similarities for example we both have two legs, two eyes, one nose.
- To name body parts for example arm, leg, head, stomach.
- To talk about what they can see, hear, taste, touch and smell for example 'I can hear the birds today' and 'I can taste the sour lemon'.
