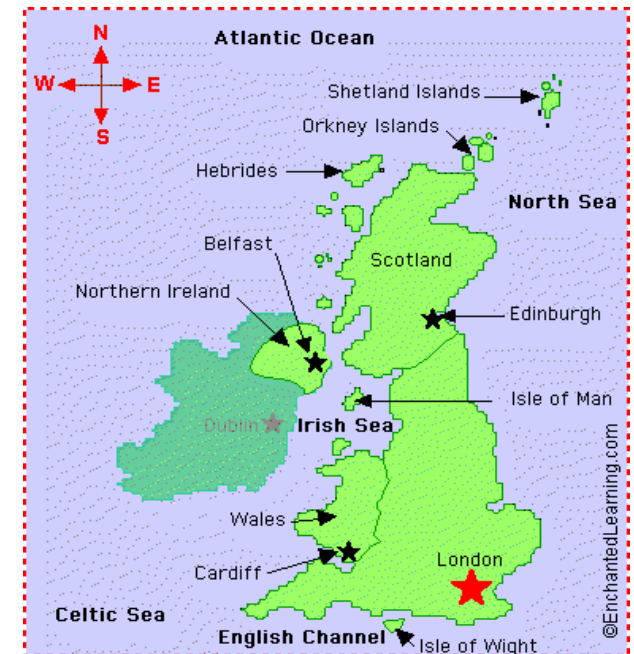
The **country** I live in is **England**.

There are **seven continents** and **five oceans** on a world map.

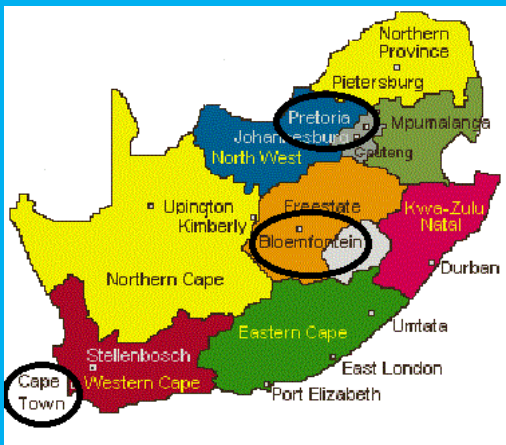
