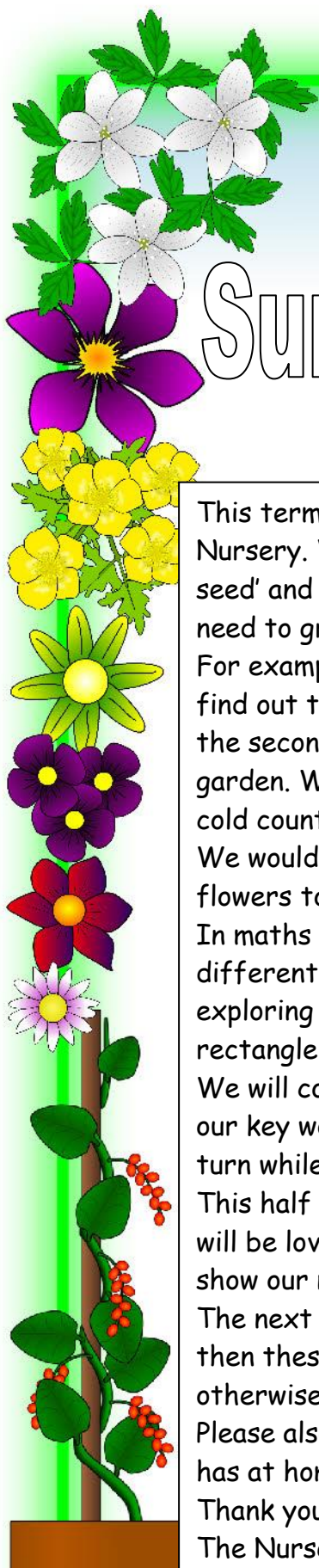




Summer Newsletter

This term we will be learning about Plants and Animals in Nursery. We will be focusing on several texts including 'A tiny seed' and 'The hungry caterpillar'. Children will learn what plants need to grow and name some minibeasts found in the garden. For example, a plant needs water and sun to grow. Children will find out that vegetables and fruit grow in the garden too. In the second half of the topic we will be exploring animals in the garden. We will also be exploring what animals live in hot and cold countries.

We would welcome donations of compost, seeds, pots, artificial flowers to support us in our topic.

In maths we will be revisiting numbers to 5 and finding different ways of representing these numbers. We will also be exploring 2-D shapes, for example, circle, triangle, square and rectangle.

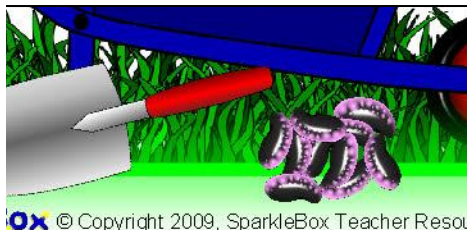
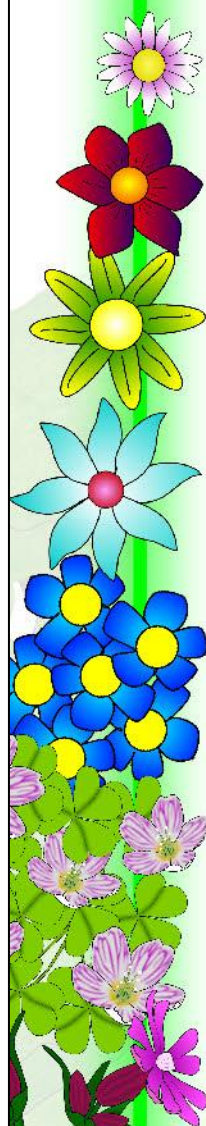
We will continue to focus on our speaking and listening skills in our key worker groups and provision ensuring children wait their turn while playing with their friends.
