This half term we will be sharing traditional tales in Nursery. We will be focusing on the story of 'Goldilocks and the 3 bears'. Children will learn who the characters are and the sequence of events that happen to Goldilocks. For example she eats the large bowl of porridge first but it is too hot. We will also have a go at making a new bed and chair for Goldilocks. As well as this book we will also read other traditional tales including 'The gingerbread man' and 'The 3 little pigs'.

In maths we will be focusing on the numbers 1,2 and 3 and children will learn how to show these numbers on their fingers and with objects.

We will continue to focus on our speaking and listening skills in our key worker groups and provision ensuring children wait their turn while playing with their friends.

This half term we have some new nursery children starting. It will be lovely for children to make some new friendships and show our new children our nursery routines.

We will be starting stay and play sessions up again in the new year but will inform you of the date nearer the time.
