Celebrate: To make something special with things like gifts, parties or activities.

Ceremony: Something done in a particular way to honour a special occasion. E.g. a wedding ceremony.

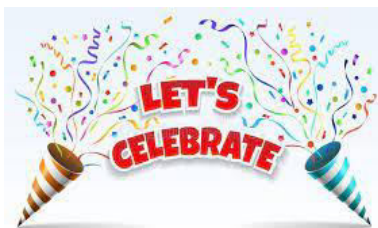
Festival: A ceremony or celebration that repeats, often once a year.

Party: People coming to gather to celebrate and have fun

Decoration: To make something more beautiful by adding to it.

Birthday: The day and month that someone was born on.

Facts to learn

Children will learn:

- To talk about what they celebrate- birthdays, weddings, parties
- To talk about how they celebrate- presents, cards, new clothes, nice food, family round
- To say where they celebrate e.g. might go to church to celebrate Christmas.
- How some people celebrate at different times e.g. Hindus celebrate Diwali.
