Phonics: Read Write Inc (RWI)

We are revisiting previously taught sounds as well as learning new sounds in phonics. We will also be continuing to learn the Red Words shown below.

Red Words

Ask children to practise reading the words across the rows, down the columns and in and out of order clearly and quickly.

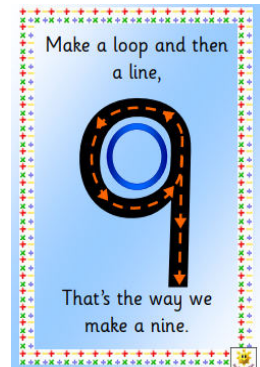
you	I	said

Maths Learning:

In Maths we will be continuing to learn the numbers 1-10 using number blocks to support this learning.

We will continue starting with the number 9.

We have been learning how to write 9 and the composition of 9
(5 + 4, 6 + 3, 2 + 7, 8 + 1)

Handwriting

Please practise writing their name with your child at home and if they can already do this they can practise their surname. In school we teach name writing with the first letter a capital and the rest of the letters lowercase.
