Read lots of stories about different plants and animals including:

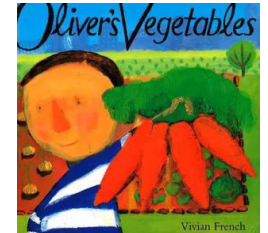
Olivers Vegetables
