Portrait: a painting or drawing of a person

Home: the place where we live

Family: a group of people who we live with or who we spend time with that are related to us.

Pet: an animal that we look after and that lives in our home.

Body: the physical parts of ourselves including skeleton.

Senses: taste, smell, touch, sound, sight

Emotions: feelings such as happy, sad, angry, worried and excited

Difference: how people or things are the same or different
