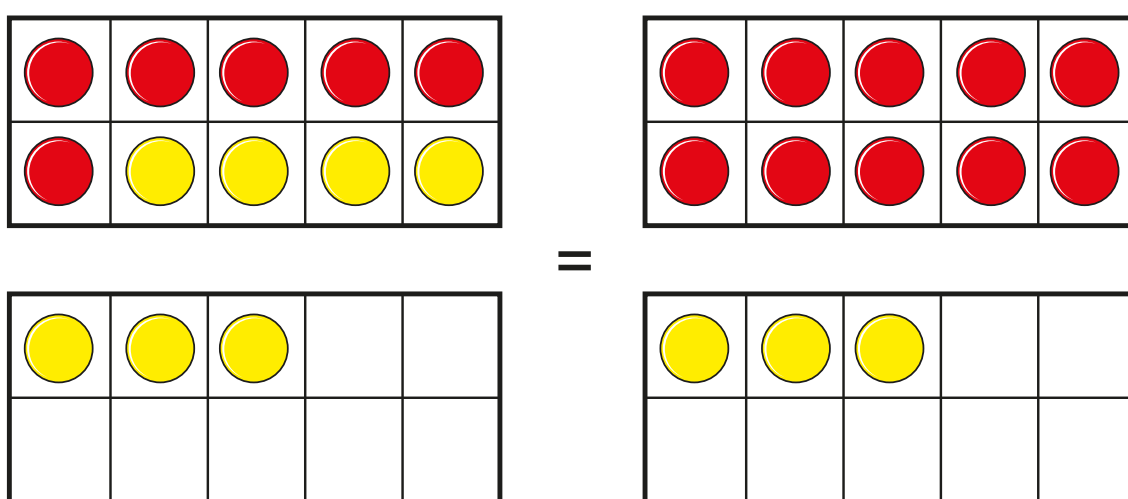


Add by making 10

a) $8 + 3 = 10 +$

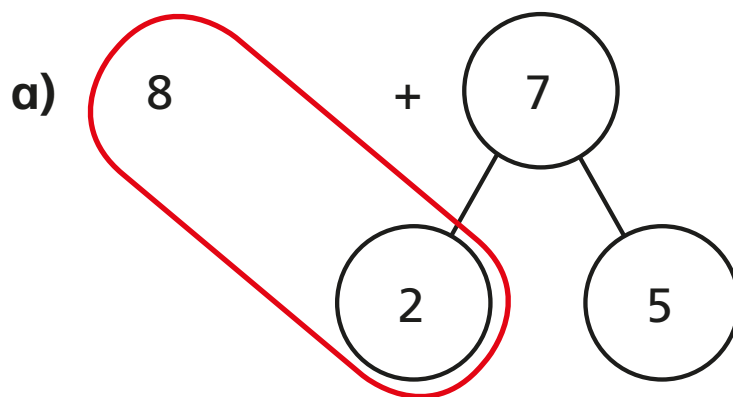
b) $9 + 7 = 10 +$
