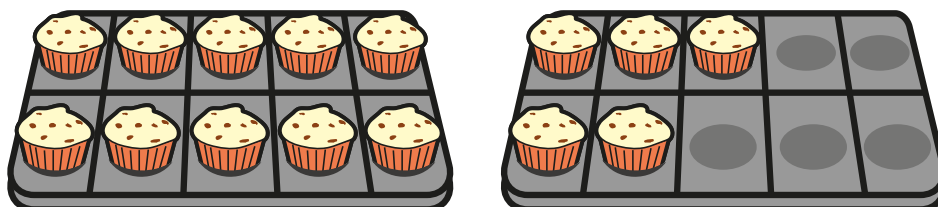


Subtraction – crossing 10 (1)

How many cakes does Rosie have left?

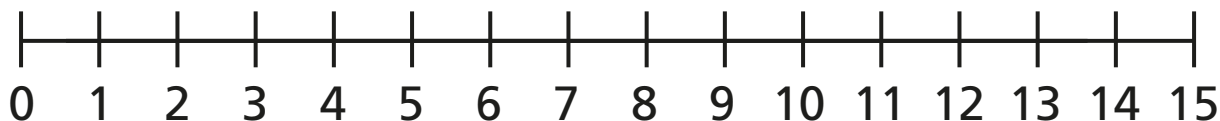
$$\square - \square = \square$$

How many stickers does Jack have left?

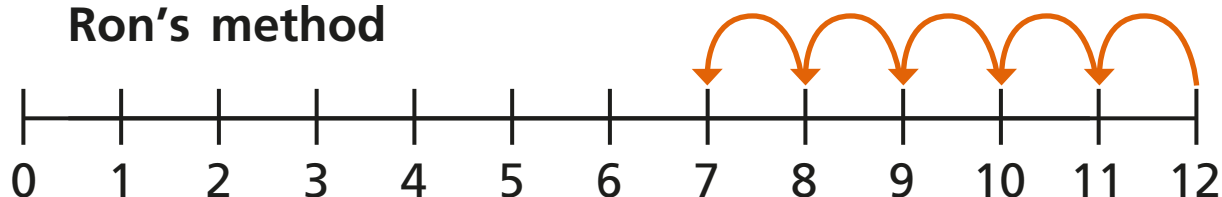

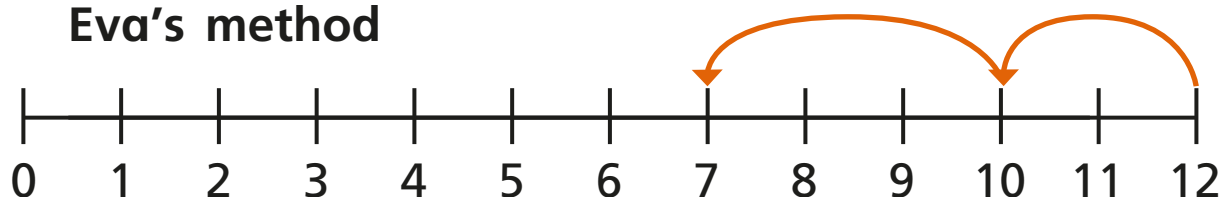
Jack has $\square$ stickers left.

Ron's method

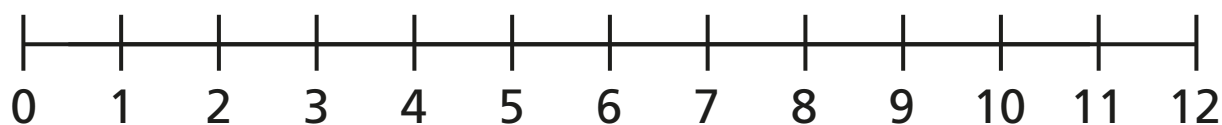


Eva's method

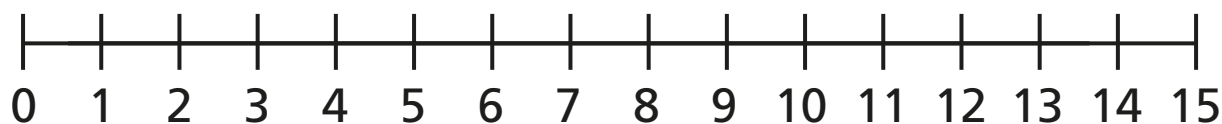

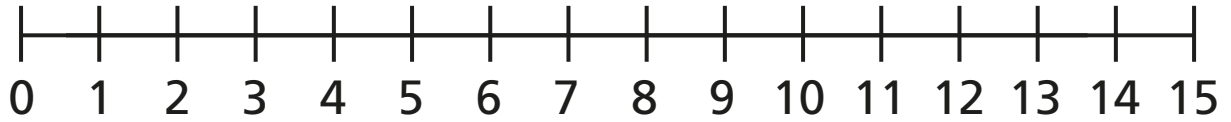

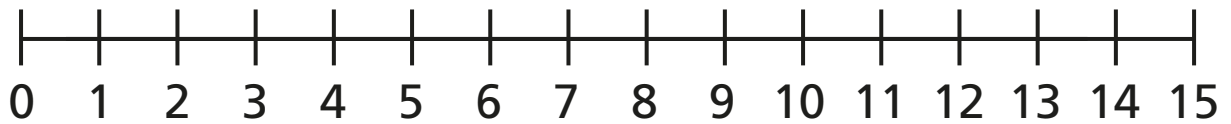
