Week 4 - Man on the Moon (writing a character description)

Lesson 1 (25.1.21) - Write down lots of expanded noun phrases around the two pictures of Bob to describe what he looks like at home and on the moon.

Lessons 2 & 3 (26.1.21 and 27.1.21) - Write the first section of Bob's character description using sentences to describe what he looks like in the story.

Lessons 4 & 5 (28.1.21 and 29.1.21) - Write the second section of Bob's character description using sentences to describe how he behaves in the story.

Week 4 Lessons 1-4 - Continuing with Time

Lesson 1 (25.1.21) - Please watch the teaching slide on Seesaw on telling the time to quarter to/ quarter past and then complete the activity.

Lesson 2 (26.1.20) - Continue with learning quarter to/past and then complete the activity.

Lesson 3 (27.1.20) - Recap o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past and complete the activity.

Lesson 4 (28.1.20) - Please watch the teaching slide on Seesaw on telling the time to 5 minutes and watch 'Telling Time Song for Kids- Telling Time to 5 Minutes' on YouTube and complete the activity based on reading the time to 5 minutes.

Lesson 5 - arithmetic (29.1.20) - Practise telling the time using the clock you have made and complete the mixed arithmetic activity.

Lesson 1 (25-01-21) slowest/fastest activity
