Week 3 Lessons 1-4 - Man on the Moon

Lesson 1 (18.1.21) - Use the story to make inferences about the main character Bob. Use the outline of Bob to write down what we know about what he looks like on the outside of the outline and what we know about how he behaves and his personality on the inside of the outline.

Lesson 2 (19.1.21) - Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram. Write a thought bubble pretending to be Bob to show how he is feeling and thinking during the story.

Lesson 3 (20.1.21) - Re-read the story. Order the events of the story carefully.

Lesson 4 (21.1.21) - Use subordinating conjunctions to extend sentences about Bob.

Lesson 3 (20.1.20) - Please watch the teaching video on seesaw and complete the activity based on telling the time (o'clock).

Lesson 4 (21.1.20) - Please watch the seesaw teaching video and/or watch the video 'Telling the Time for Kids: Half Past Times' on YouTube and complete the activity provided.

Lesson 5 (22.1.21) - Practising a mixture of reading and writing the time (o'clock and half past).
