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Year 2 Home Learning - English

We will be adding to Seesaw and the school website as we go so please keep checking to see what has been uploaded.

Week 1 lessons 1-3 - Space Poetry

Lesson 1 (6.1.21) - "Jump Over the Moon," the Cow Declared poem. Please either read the poem in your work pack or access the poem and video introduction on Seesaw. Answer the questions using the poem. Mrs Shaw's group will need to read the poem 'Footprints' and answer the questions underneath.

Lesson 2 (7.1.21) - Choose one of the space poems to perform. You can also access a video on Seesaw teaching you how to perform a poem. You can record your poem and sent it on Seesaw or the school learning email.

Lesson 3 (8.1.21) - Collecting ideas for your own space poem. Use the space images on the sheets and record words around each image to use next week.

Week 2 Lesson 1-5 - Space poetry/Man on the Moon story

Lesson 1 (11.1.21) - Use the planning sheet and words you wrote down last week to write your own space poem. Use the example to help you understand how to write it. There will be a teaching video on Seesaw to help you.

Lesson 2 (12.1.21) - Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram. Read the first four pages of the story. Please watch the video on Seesaw of the story being read and how to make predictions. Retell the main events and begin to make your prediction.

Lesson 3 (13.1.21) - Re-read the first four pages. Write your own prediction about what will happen next in the story onto the sheet provided or on the note page on Seesaw.

Lesson 4 (14.1.21) - Read the rest of the Man on the Moon story or watch it being read on Seesaw and the teaching video on how to infer about a character. Write down what we know about Bob and how we know this onto the sheet.

Lesson 5 (15.1.21) - In this lesson, we will explore the main character of Bob in more detail. Imagine you could ask Bob some questions. What would you like to ask him?
Record your questions around the image.
