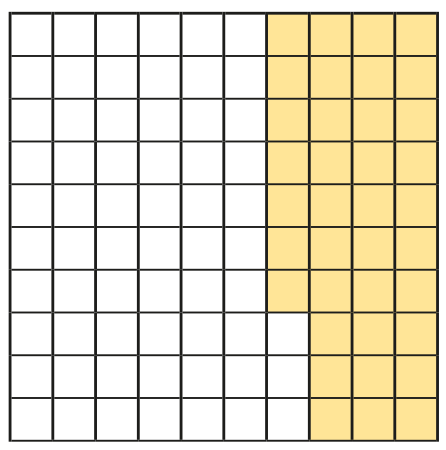


Bonds to 100 (tens and ones)

1 Here is a hundred square.



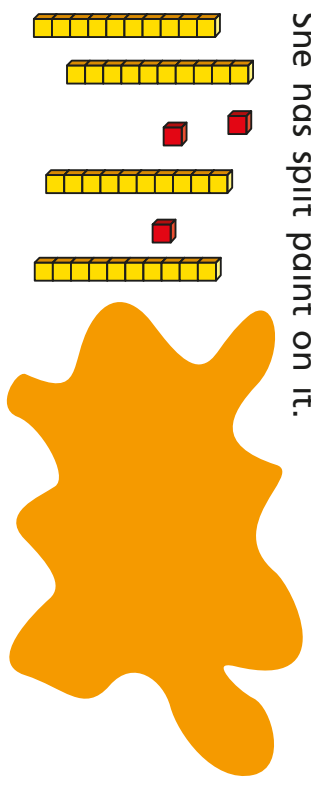
How many squares are shaded?

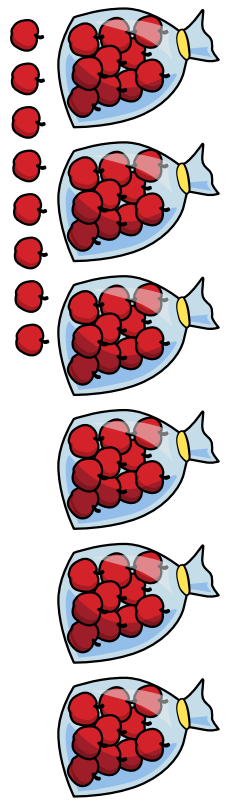
2 Eva has made 100 using base 10

3 Mrs Harris has these apples for Sports Day.

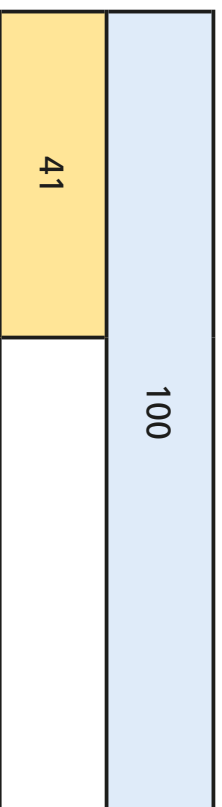


She needs 100 apples.
