There are some pictures below to give you some ideas.

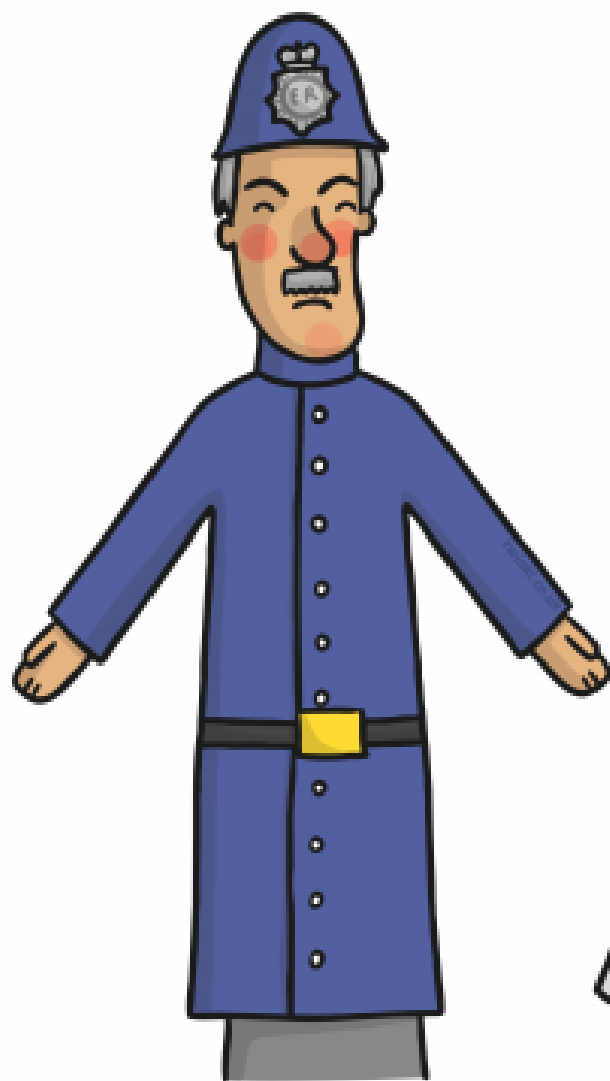
You might like to make:

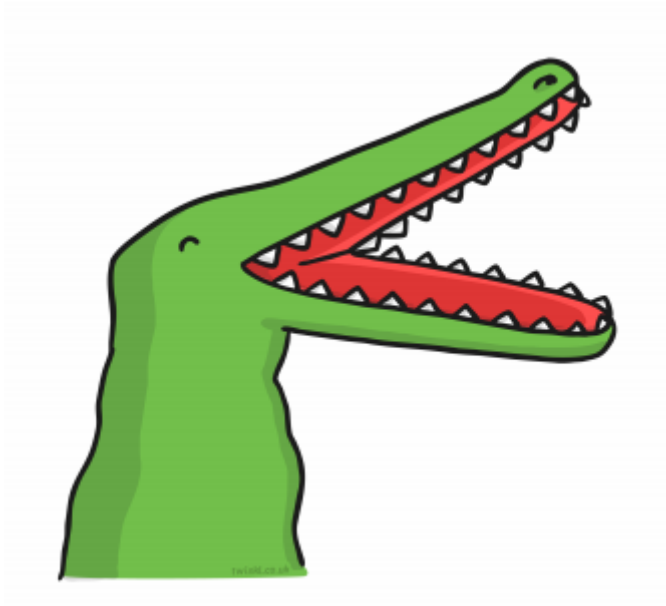
- A collage—use different materials you have at home such as paint, card, ribbon, cotton wool etc
