The tasks will be directly linked to the work sent home in the work packs.

In your work pack you will find that we have given you your log ins for Bugclub, Purple Mash, TTRS and Seesaw so you can access these at home. Please make sure you keep these folders safe and do not throw away any work as some parts will be needed for a few weeks.

Seesaw

Everyday there will be English, Maths, Guided Reading and a foundation subject lesson uploaded. These lessons will sometimes have videos to watch on Seesaw that will explain the task. All the sheets that you will need will be in your work pack. After each session you should take a photo of your work and upload it to Seesaw or complete the work on Seesaw itself. A Y5 teacher will give you feedback daily. Each week either Miss Moss, Miss Warren, Mrs Sturman or Mr Walton will be uploading the videos and giving you explanations about your work. Please remember that you should not be commenting on anyone else's work and that teachers will only be responding to work that has been set by them and not anything else that you upload. Please also remember that you should not be changing your profile photo, you already have an image set for you.

Bug Club

In your work pack you will see your Bug Club login. This is an online reading service where you have been set a particular level for your reading and you have a large variety of books to choose from to read online. Please make sure you regularly log in and read. Your teacher will be checking that you have been reading the books and can assign you a new selection when we feel you are ready.
